

# SUGARBIRD LADY

## TB and Piano

Robin Miller (1940-1975), aviator and nurse, was a Western Australian pioneer. Her nickname amongst the indigenous community was 'Sugarbird Lady'; she flew, often solo, all over outback Western Australia administering more than 30,000 doses of the polio vaccine, sabin, by putting it on sugar cubes for her patients to take orally. She also worked for the Royal Flying Doctor Service, saving lives and attending to the sick, transporting people to hospitals in WA from remote locations. Robin flew across the world delivering small planes to Western Australia for the use of the RFDS. She died aged 35 of cancer, a courageous woman still working for the good of the community to the very end.
